Good afternoon,

As two people were recently confirmed in Broward with Coronavirus, local awareness and concerns are increasing each day. On behalf of the Board, rest assured that Club leadership, together with ORCA and the Medical Center are coordinating all communication efforts and action items. We are working together to identify and share best practices, and aligned in knowing that the safety of all persons here in the Ocean Reef community is paramount.

Your Club has made it a priority to meet regularly with our management team and associates on the latest CDC preventative best practices including identifying symptoms and encouraging anyone feeling sick to stay home. We have also been reviewing and monitoring every area of the Club where Members interact with Associates, as well as where Associates interact with each other. In addition to our standard practices, proactive measures continue to be evaluated in all locations including placing hand sanitizer in all Member facing areas and Associate high traffic locations, additional trainings for common area cleaning, cleaning of cart steering wheels, increased wiping down of fitness equipment and other high touch areas. We will continue to implement additional preventative measures as appropriate throughout the Club.

As a reminder of what the CDC and other experts have published, we encourage all Members and Associates to:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Cover your cough or sneeze into your elbow, or into a tissue and throw it in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.

As the situation continues to evolve, it is important that you have the latest information. To that extent, we've included the web links below for the CDC and Florida Department of Health. Additionally, we are working with the Medical Center to provide information to all Members on a weekly basis through the Ocean Reef Press.
