

# MESSAGE FROM YOUR CLUB: CORONAVIRUS

Dear Member,

As referenced in our prior communications, your Ocean Reef Club Board and Management team continue to implement contingency plans specific to Club operations.

One area of critical importance to all Members is Food & Beverage, as it is such a key part of our Ocean Reef daily life. We have anticipated and planned for a situation in the days and weeks to come where we will likely need to curtail or entirely suspend operations in our dining facilities.

As of this writing, all restaurants are open for normal operations. To that end, we have a well-developed contingency plan to provide extended private dining and take out services throughout the community. The Club has established procedures that are in place and ready to implement as soon as necessary. Just as we did after Hurricane Irma, our Associates are ready to pivot into new roles. Our commissary has proactively ordered additional back stock, we have developed appropriate menus, and our various kitchens are preparing for this change in service.

As we continue to safeguard the community, we recommend social distancing in tight spaces. Beginning Sunday, March 15, a few measures we are implementing include - we will not have any buffets available and have canceled cooking school classes. The lobby, the Clubhouse and Point will continue complimentary coffee service, however pastry items have been eliminated. We will have attendants in these areas to assist with service and reduce touch points. Also, the Food & Beverage team has implemented drop off service for Private Dining, and in all dining outlets, our servers will offer to sign your checks for you. Most importantly, cleaning and sanitizing of areas and equipment continues to be frequent and thorough.

Although the gym will remain open and personal training services will continue, all indoor group fitness classes at the Member Fitness Center will be canceled beginning Monday, March 16. The Card & Games Room has also been closed until further notice and Tuesday's Shamrock Shake Beach Party has been canceled. More distance has also been put between the chaise lounges on Buccaneer Island and stools at the Beach Bar.

This is a rapidly changing situation and we greatly appreciate your attention, diligence and concern for the well-being of the entire community. We recommend that you make your family and guests aware that amenities and services will be curtailed, and that further service limitations will likely occur.
