LODGING & ASSOCIATE HOUSING

The Club has complied with the Monroe County Emergency Management directive for our Inn and Vacation Rental program (including Marina rentals), that disallows any short term rentals (defined as less than 28 days) in Monroe County effective yesterday, Sunday, March 22nd. If a Member rents their property outside of the Club's program, whether with another on-site program, Broker or on their own, they too are required to comply. It is the law but just as importantly, it is best for our entire community. A tremendous effort has been made to help all Seasonal Associates living in our dormitory housing to relocate either to their next seasonal position or home before their scheduled departure date which normally early to mid-May. As of Thursday, March 26th, all Staff Housing will be closed with the exception of a few year-round staff.

GOLF

Bag Room Open Cancelled. The difficult decision to cancel the remainder of the Bag Room Open has been made. On behalf of everyone on the Ocean Reef Club and Card Sound Golf Club Professional Staffs, we would like to thank everyone for their support. Part of this decision comes down to the fact that some remaining participants have to depart the Club due to home state travel restrictions, airport closures and a desire to be home safe with family. Another factor is the safety of the Membership. Golf Club Bag Storage is closed for the remainder of the season. If you have golf clubs stored with the Club, please come by and pick them up or call the Golf Shop at 305-367-5912, and we can have them delivered or shipped to you. The driving range remains open. We are asking all players to leave the area while we replenish balls. Also, the golf courses remain open for play. We have removed the rakes and reconfigured the holes on each green to stop the need for removing the flags. Both golf courses have starters and rangers should you have any questions.

AIRPORT & MARINA

Airport Remains open, full service. Marina Remains open with Marina Dock Office hours from 7am – 4pm.

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

Reminder that the Solid Waste team will not be coming into garages or residences for pick-up. Please continue to put your garbage in cans or recycling bins and simply leave outside your residence. You do not need to pull it all the way to the curb. Condos do not need to do anything differently. Please continue to leave waste under building enclosures as has always been done. Trash and recycling collection will continue normal in-season pick up schedule.

OTHER COMMUNITY AREAS:

Greenberg Park is open, with a reminder to practice social distancing while at the Park. (No food or beverage is permitted.) Dog Park is open. We ask that everyone practice social distancing. Iberia Bank is open for regular business hours (M-F 9am – 4pm) serving all clients through their Golf Cart Drive Thru window. Walk-ups are also welcome. Other services and access to safe deposit boxes are by appointment. Bank of America, Ocean Reef Financial Center office is closed. Wynn's continues to remain open on their usual office hours. We urge anyone shopping there to please practice social distancing, and we are working with Wynn's on additional best practices. Farmer's Market will continue to take place on Mondays and Thursdays. We recommend social distancing and ask that you only handle items that you intend on purchasing.

In order to best safeguard all Members and Associates, we ask that everyone in our Community continue to be attentive and adhere to the CDC guidelines and best practices. Should you have any visitors who have traveled domestically or overseas and have arrived at Ocean Reef in the past week, or will arrive, we urge you to ask them to self-quarantine for a 14-day period upon arriving at Ocean Reef.
