

# Dolphin Course Renovations Explained

Ocean Reef's Director of Agronomy, Eric Bennett, used this photo taken June 17th to give a detailed description of the many exciting renovations being made to the Dolphin Course:



"To the far end, just beyond the north side of the Clubhouse, is the 10th tee area. Obviously, all of the turf has been removed and we have begun the process of reshaping the teeing ground. All of the tees on hole 10 will be shifted west slightly to make room for the cooling pad and more parking at the Clubhouse.

Just west of the 10th tee is the new location for the 9th green. The entire area has been demolished and the new green is currently being constructed in the photo. The green has

shifted dramatically to the west and the south bringing the water into play. In the photo, the crew is hard at work digging the trenches for the herringbone pattern drainage system.

On the other side of the lake, directly behind number 18 green, you will find our new teeing ground for the 9th

hole. The tee has also moved dramatically, however, it was shift west and to the north. The teeing ground will be beautifully landscaped creating separation between 18 green and 9 tee. Overall, the hole will be slightly shorter but much more difficult.

The extremely white oval on the southern portion of

the photo is our new practice putting green. It has been completely constructed with the exception of the sand and turf grass. All shaping and drainage has been completed. The putting green is slightly smaller than our previous putting green, yet has fewer contours creating more space to practice straighter putts."
