Celebrating the Impact of Senate Bill 10

May 9, 2022, will be the fifth anniversary of the signing of Senate Bill 10, the legislation that solidified the Everglades Agricultural Area (EAA) Reservoir south of Lake Okeechobee as the most important project for Everglades restoration.

Those who lived in Ocean Reef in 2015 will no doubt remember when upwards of 50,000 acres of precious seagrass died in Florida Bay.

Seagrass is critical to the health of the Bay, one of the world's greatest fisheries and, here in Key Largo, a top destination for divers and snorkelers.

The seagrass die-off was caused by the combination of excess salinity and low

dissolved oxygen in the Bay, which in turn was connected to the diversion of freshwater away from its natural southerly path through the Everglades.

Instead of flowing from Lake Okeechobee down to Florida Bay, much of the freshwater is dumped west to the Caloosahatchee River and east to the St. Lucie River. There, the nutrient-laden Lake Okeechobee water fuels toxic algae blooms that kill sea life and destroy tourism and real

estate.

Thanks to Senate Bill 10, the EAA Reservoir is on a fast track, with unprecedented funding by both state and federal governments. It is a massive undertaking: The project footprint is larger than the island of Manhattan, and besides the 10,100acre reservoir, a 6,500-acre constructed wetland will purify water from the reservoir so it can be safely discharged into the Everglades and Florida Bay.

Once completed, and in conjunction with other Everglades restoration projects already completed or underway, the new EAA Reservoir will reduce the algae-causing discharges to the coastal estuaries by 55% and provide 120 billion more gallons of clean water for the Everglades and Florida Bay every year, according to the South Florida Water Management District.

So, happy birthday Senate Bill 10! No project is more critical to the health of Florida Bay and the quality of life here in Ocean Reef than the EAA Reservoir.

Reef Departure Reminders

Travel Planning Tips

If you are planning to travel this summer, be sure to check on the current COVID-19 information. The Centers for Disease Control website (www.cdc.gov) provides updated travel information. To avoid delays, carry your COVID-19 vaccination card and take a photo of your card with your cell phone in the event you lose your wallet or handbag. Additionally, update and take a list of current medications with you. In the event of a health crisis, this provides needed information for the health care provider. If you are unsure about your current medications or

dosages, please contact your Medical Center physician.

Automatic Pharmacy Refills & Delivery

Please contact your Key Largo pharmacy and update the instructions for your automatically refilled prescriptions that are picked up by Public Safety. Once picked up by Public Safety they cannot be returned or refilled by another pharmacy. This could leave you in a dilemma, especially when it's a critically needed medication. The Medical Center can support your offseason prescription needs by electronic communication with your preferred pharmacy.

Check for Expired Medications to Dispose

Solid dose over the counter



medications such as tablets and capsules appear to be the most stable past their expiration date. However, medications can and do change in potency depending on heat, light and humidity factors

Expired prescriptions that contain preservatives, such as ophthalmic (eye) drops, may be unsafe past their expiration date. The outdated preservatives may allow

bacterial growth in the solution. It's a good practice to check the expiration dates on all medications and properly dispose of those past their prime.

Many medications are not good for the environment and shouldn't be

flushed into the sewage system. Sedatives or other narcotic type medications should not be thrown into the trash unless they are crushed or dissolved and mixed into something unpalatable – like coffee grounds. You can also drop them at the Medical Center or Public Safety's drop box for proper disposal.



New Chapel Opening This Sunday...Maybe

Now, almost two years later, to the date, we are hoping to have our first worship service in the new chapel, this Sunday, May 8th. I say hoping, because we will find out if we will receive a temporary Certificate of Occupancy later this week. Please check the chapel website at orcchapel.org. There will be an email blast sent out on Friday as well.

If we receive the temporary Certificate of Occupancy, the Protestant Congregation will have its first worship service

Important Parking Information

If we are able to have our worship services in the New Chapel, please carefully read the following information about parking.

- Please note there is no entry into the South Parking Lot from Ocean Reef Drive.
 You must enter from Island Drive and exit only onto Ocean Reef Drive.
- If you are able, we encourage you to park in the Business Center parking lot, across the street, and walk to the New Chapel.
- You can drop off at the South Island Drive entrance to the Chapel, and then park.
- The South Island Drive entrance is a level entrance with no stairs.
- There is a Drop-off cutout on the Ocean Reef Entrance to the Chapel. This entrance involves several steps.
- There is parking for golf carts in the South parking area.

Gold Diggers With Six Legs!



"Nature Notes" by Nancy Zakon

My husband said this sounded like three dates during his bachelor days. That aside, these Golden Digger Wasps are nice they don't sting, their tunnels aerate your yard, and they dine on underground lawn pests like Green June Beetle larva. You've probably seen them - flying in dizzying circles close to the ground. With habitat ranging from Canada to South America, digger wasps no doubt visited you, even up north. Here's what makes them unique. They are solitary - yes. Unlike their gregarious paper wasp cousins, digger wasps do not colonize, and do not build "nests" as we know them. Instead, the females in May-August dig many tunnels 3-15 inches down in dry soil where they lay just one egg each. Because the egg needs food, mama wasp paralyzes one of your lawn pests, and drags it down the tunnel for baby. (Note: horror show alert: the pest is not dead, so baby has fresh bug to eat while growing.) What do mom and dad eat? (Bambi alert: they only eat nectar from nearby flowers,



helping to pollinate as they go.) And mom expires after her eggs are laid. The egg hatches two weeks later as an adult digger wasp, to mate and begin the life cycle anew, living for 1-2 months. Digger wasps return to the same area year after year. One note on the "not stinging" wasps. The males do not have stingers. The ladies are shy and would rather avoid conflict, as usual, but will sting if grabbed, as usual. If you have children playing in your yard - maybe digging in sand, be on the lookout for digger wasps. They like open, sunny areas of dry soil or sand. You'll recognize holes about 1/4 inch wide, and digger wasps flying nearby in rapid circles just above the ground. (Size is ½-1 inch long, perhaps bluish tint to their wings.) And if you see them on golf courses (sand traps?), you can easily walk through them. They will scatter and regroup when you leave. They are passive insects that just like to mate, eat, and dig! "You dig it?"!

I was always impressed that they would send their luggage ahead (often with mixed success in the dark days of the '80s). They would have liked the premium luggage service,

Pack your bag, bike, golf clubs, or skis and they will do the rest with guaranteed on-time white glove pick-up and delivery to homes, hotels, and even cruise lines with 24-hour bespoke customer service. Nice!

Queue & A:

Unless you are flying private, the rest of us average-Joes at some point or other will have to queue through security. It seems most everybody has TSA precheck security screening used at 200 airports and 81 airlines (register here: www.tsa. gov/tsa-precheck) but I am a big fan of Clear (www.Clearme. com) which has personal escorts to speed you through security lines with a biometric tap of your finger or blink of your eye at their dedicated kiosks. Clear can be found at airports in 35+ cities nationwide and brings you right to the front of the TSA Precheck security line.

For fellow international jet-setters, the Department of Homeland Security's Global Entry Card is a must: skip the long immigration lines and use the Global Entry Kiosk at 75 international airports. It is remarkably quick and easy to use; sign-up and schedule an enrollment appointment at https://ttp.cbp.dhs.gov.

Just three months ago, the US Customs and Border Protection launched its new dedicated Mobile Passport Control (MPC) app (https:// mobilepassport.us) which helps Americans and Canadians speed through lengthy immigration lines at dedicated CBP MPC lanes at 33+ US international airports and seaports. This new version is now the official app of the US Department of Homeland Security and makes international travel a snap.
