# Carysfort Reef: A Catalyst for Community Resilience

Ocean Reef Club® and Coral Restoration Foundation<sup>TM</sup> have a beautiful history of collaboration around restoration work at the iconic Carysfort Reef. In 2015, Coral Restoration Foundation<sup>TM</sup> entered a five-year partnership with Ocean Reef Club® to re-populate the site with 30,000 corals, saving the reef from extinction. By the end of 2020, we had returned more than 34,000 corals to Carysfort. The impact of this work has had an extraordinary ripple effect throughout the community. The success of our work together at Carysfort provided the inspiration and a launching pad for Mission: Iconic Reefs, one of the biggest restoration efforts in the world. Coral restoration at this scale is now recognized as critical to the way of life here in the Keys and largescale restoration work is now being acknowledged as having the capacity to improve livelihoods and diversify the local economy.

In July 2021, Coral Restoration Foundation<sup>TM</sup> was awarded a grant of just under \$2 million by United Way of Collier and the Keys (UWCK) to support ongoing work at Carysfort Reef. This funding was the first significant investment in sites targeted by the Mission: Iconic Reefs plan. This competitive grant is part of UWCK's "Revitalizing the Florida Keys through Reef Restoration and Beyond" initiative, with support from the United Arab Emirates. UWCK's goal is to revitalize the coral reefs - the lifeblood of the Florida Keys economy while supporting sustainability through education, outreach, and community impact.

Under this grant, CRFTM

will return more than 14,500 threatened elkhorn and staghorn corals to Carysfort Reef – in addition to the 20,000 corals they will bring to the site funded by other sources. The grant will also directly infuse millions of dollars into the Keys economy, provide 120 internships to students over the next five years, engage over 1,000 volunteers in reef restoration, and provide seasonal employment and added revenue to community residents and dive shops. As part of this grant, CRFTM committed to match UWCK's funding: \$389,000 annually for five years. And, once again, members of the Ocean Reef community are stepping up in support, beginning with a grant from the Ocean Reef Conservation Association and John Davidson who has committed a significant donation from his family foundation.

Davidson explains "I will never forget the day when I first jumped in the water at Pennekamp Park as a teenager. The colors and the diversity of life were breathtaking. CRFTM is our best hope for bringing our reefs back to their previous glory. Our coral reefs are our most unique and valuable resource, we need to restore and preserve them for future generations." The Davidson Family is also galvanizing the Rod and Gun Club and other

Ocean Reef Club® Members to join the mission, "This is a great opportunity to have a real impact with a donation that goes directly to restore Carysfort Reef with matching funds."

Thanks to the ongoing support of the members of

the Ocean Reef community, Carysfort Reef is becoming much more than an iconic reef site – its recovery is now a catalyst for creating sustainable community resilience in the Florida Keys and a model for restoration internationally.

## Memberabilia Russell Post... An Ocean Reef Mover & Shaker

For more than fifty years Russ Post's involvement with Ocean Reef has taken precedence over almost everything else in his life... In 1974 he became General Manager of the evolving Ocean Reef Club and from 1980 until 1991 he served as the President. In the ensuing years he earned the reputation as Ocean Reef's most successful realtor and as an unstinting supporter of the ORC, not only financially but also with his time and energy.

# The year was 1974 and Russ was only 25 years old.... "I had energy but no focus."

Three years before he was just another college graduate and Vietnam vet looking for a job.


His hometown in Indiana was not an option. The choice there was either a factory or a farm and he had no interest in either of them.

Russ decided to move on. He debated between California and Florida won.

"I had to make a living and I took any job that was available. But every Wednesday I quit painting houses or whatever, dressed in a suit and tie and answered help wanted ads."

On one of those fateful Wednesdays Russ interviewed at Ocean Reef and was offered an entry level job in the Controller's office at the princely wage of \$2.10 an hour. (He did not, as rumor has it, begin as a bell boy. Although he is convinced that he would have made more money if the rumor had been true.)

Russ came to Ocean Reef when the Club was just

with Harper Sibley, Russ woke up with a list of responsibilities that even today he finds difficult to believe.

"I had 500 employees. I was in charge of managing – the Inn; rentals; restaurants; bars; recreation; marina; roads; security; sewers; water treatment – plus every new project that came along. And there were plenty of them."

Russ was on board for the construction of the Harbor (now Hammock) golf course and the Barracuda (now Card Sound) golf course; the tennis center; Fishing Village with new retail outlets; relocated employee housing; refurbished hotel rooms; Snapper Point development; creation of the Art League, the first resident M.D. The list is endless.

Russell Post suffered through some bad times at Ocean Reef – financial crises, management changes, hurricanes. But mostly he remembers the good times.

"In the 70's the routine was to have cocktails at the Reef Lounge, dinner at the Ocean Room or in Key Largo, often at Marvin's – a very offbeat and insider restaurant (cash only and no reservation unless recommended by a regular). Marvin cooked with the help of many of his patrons ('I was always assigned to frying the bread'). His wife Dottie, who had a mouth like a longshoreman, did everything else, aided by just one busboy.'

"The evenings usually ended

In 1979 General Alexander Haig, Jr., then the White House Chief of Staff under President Nixon (he later became Reagan's Sec. of State), brought the conference of NATO Defense Ministers to ORC. Russ was helpful to the General and their relationship evolved into a friendship. In subsequent years Russ encouraged General Haig to schedule meetings and vacations at The Reef. (Russ named his son Alex after the General.)

Russell Post also shared some unforgettable meals and latenight after-dinner drinks with Richard Nixon, who came to Ocean Reef as the guest of his confidante **Bebe Rebozo**. On more than one of Nixon's visits to Ocean Reef, Russ joined the former president and Bebe Rebozo for those ritual after-dinner drinks. "Once we saw the sun rise and were served breakfast by the chef, who came in at 3:30 a.m. to prep for the coming day."

Russ is a great storyteller. One favorite celebrity tale is of Sammy Davis Jr., who one Christmas was alone on his boat, which was docked at the Marina.

leaving the cocoon and becoming a butterfly. Harper Sibley (co-owner with Morris Burke) designed a plan for the transformation of Ocean Reef into what he described as "an extremely exclusive private family club".

The extent of the proposed changes stunned the Ocean Reef homeowners and overwhelmed the management. It was a perfect storm for a bright, ambitious, and hardworking young man and Russ, who had already been promoted to the Reservations Desk, was positioned to take advantage of it.

Still Russ was surprised when Harper Sibley (whom he scarcely knew) invited him for a drink and announced "I could run this place but I don't have time. My General Manager is drunk by 3 in the afternoon. You are here morning to night and you make good decisions. Do you think you can handle the job?"

Russ's response was immediate – "I was 25 years old and didn't know my ass from first base, but that didn't stop me. I said 'Mr. Sibley, I'll do it. I'll figure it out and I only hope you are patient.""

Of course, Russ did "figure it out" but the challenge required a full-time commitment. For Russell Post it was the beginning of a lifetime involvement with Ocean Reef Club.

The day after his conversation

There was an Ocean Reef holiday party and Russ invited Sammy to come, assuring him there would be no piano and they were not expecting him to entertain. "Twenty minutes after he arrived, he asked us to bring in a piano and it was 'show time'. An evening none of us lucky to be there will ever forget."

After the member buyout in 1991 Russell Post decided it was time to become his own boss and he started Russell Post Properties. He specialized in buying, selling and renting properties at Ocean Reef Club, it's a task that he has continued to do in one way or another for the past 30 years.

Very quickly Russ Post's name became synonymous with Ocean Reef real estate sales. He built a company filled with loyal employees (many of whom he trained and supported when they formed their own organizations).

For the past four years he has been President of Ocean Reef Club Sotheby's (the company was purchased from him by the Club in 2018). He is leaving this position this month – a step towards retirement, but only a step. Russ will have an office at ORC Sotheby's and along with his partner Molly Taylor, he will continue to offer real estate services to Ocean Reef Members. He will also be a

frequent commuter to his other existing offices in Islamorada, Marathon and Key West.

Over the years Russell Post has managed the sale of OR real estate with intelligence, ingenuity and an unparalleled work ethic. He has also been a generous supporter of many of the important Ocean Reef ventures.

Russ has been a major donor

to the Medical Center, the Cultural Center, the Art League, the Chapel; and the Academy (where his three children, now all of them in college, received their early education).

The Club, as well as a significant number of Members, have reason to be grateful that Russell Post "found his focus" at Ocean Reef.


The Sotheby's office remains open seven days a week this summer, and always welcomes Members to stop by and say hello.



# Summer Preparedness

According to the National Center for Environmental Information's Global Annual Temperature Rankings outlook, it is virtually certain (> 99.0%) that 2022 will rank among the 10 warmest years on record.

Remember your summertime arsenal of a hat, sunblock and lip sunscreen. The Skin Cancer Foundation recommends a water-resistant, broad-spectrum sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher for any extended outdoor activity. Regardless of the SPF, though, it's important to apply one ounce (two tablespoons) 30 minutes before going outside and reapply it every two hours or immediately after swimming or sweating. Try to limit tennis, golf and other strenuous activities to the early morning hours and prehydrate before exercising. Once

Mara Cakans, N.P. states the following: "Summer months mean more time outdoors in the heat where it's easy to become dehydrated. Stay on top of hydration not only with extra water, but electrolytes to replace salt and other minerals when

you perspire. Some good food sources of electrolytes are: dairy products, bananas, coconut water, watermelon and avocado."



# Look Up in the Sky!

It's a Bird! It's a Plane! It's a DRONF!

Even if you were not at The Reef during Celebration Weekend, you most likely heard about the amazing Drone Show that captivated Members on Friday and Saturday night. All eyes were on the sky and it truly was an "out of this world" experience. During the show, everyone gazed up and wondered out loud...how did they do this? The questions continued for days as Ocean Reef Members could not stop talking about this spectacular event.



#### What is a Drone Show?

A drone light show is a collection of UAV (Unmanned Aerial Vehicles) operating in a planned sequence to display 3D images, animations, and lighting. The drones are controlled by a computer program that gives specific commands and communicates to the drones via a radio signal. The ground control engineers monitor each drone that is fully charged and then readied carefully for its flight.

#### Who Did this Show?

Ocean Reef Club selected Sky Elements Drone Shows out of Fort Worth, Texas to deliver this new form of aerial entertainment for Celebration Weekend. Their designers worked with the Ocean Reef Member Events Team to create a meaningful show that was unique to our Club. Sky Elements put together an incredible drone video of the show, which can be viewed at https://youtu.be/P8iiM9FFM8o. Even if you saw it from the ground, this video offers a whole new perspective and

insight into what they do.

#### **Some Notable Facts & Figures:**

- Each show had 200 drones.
- The show lasted 10 minutes.
- The drones have very bright LED lights.
- The drones can fly up to 400 feet above ground level.
- Drones cannot fly in the rain or in windy conditions.

#### **Safety First!**

All FAA guidelines and other agency requirements were followed for the proper use of air space. Obtaining permits and planning was in the works for months.

Drone light shows will continue to be a new form of entertainment as they are not only a wondrous sight in the sky, but also eco-friendly. Your Ocean Reef Club recognized that this drone show would be one of the highlights of our Celebration Weekend and thereby create another fabulous memory for Members. Certainly one none of us will forget!





# What is Active Isolated Stretching (AIS) and What are Some Benefits?

There are over 600 muscles in the human body. The Active Isolated Stretching (AIS) protocol includes 300 different stretches to help alleviate those overused areas. The AIS method of muscle lengthening and fascial release is a type of Athletic Stretching Technique that provides effective, dynamic, facilitated stretching of major muscle groups. AIS provides functional and physiological restoration of superficial and deep fascial planes. Over the past few decades, many experts have advocated that stretching should last up to 60 seconds. For years, this prolonged static stretching technique was the gold standard. However, prolonged static stretching decreases the blood flow within the tissue creating localized ischemia (inadequate blood supply) and lactic acid buildup. This can potentially cause irritation or injury of local muscular, tendinous, lymphatic, and neural tissues, comparable to the effects and consequences of trauma and overuse syndromes. Performing an Active Isolated Stretch of no longer than

two seconds allows the target muscles to optimally lengthen without triggering the protective stretch reflex and subsequent reciprocal antagonistic muscle contraction as the isolated muscle achieves a state of relaxation. These stretches provide maximum benefit and can be accomplished without opposing tension or resulting trauma.

#### **AIS Benefit of Sciatica**

The most common issue that I have encountered is sciatica. One benefit that AIS provides is improving or potentially curing this nerve issue. Sciatica is pain that radiates down the sciatic nerve (from compression of a spinal nerve root) to the toes. There are many contributing factors to sciatica. Sometimes a person can get sciatica simply by having his wallet in his back pocket and sitting on it for periods of time. The pressure caused by the wallet can cause pain. At other times the pain is caused by trauma to the low back such as a fall or a rotatory movement injury. A rotary injury can be caused when you turn at the hips quickly before warming up the low-back tissue. The most common problems we see are the tight muscles over the top of the sciatic nerve. When the muscles near the sciatic nerve are tight, they tend to apply constant pressure to the nerve causing agitation.

How I might alleviate the pressure is by stretching the gluteal muscles first. After the gluteal muscles are flexible, I will then stretch the hamstrings.

Both need to be flexible and functioning so I can stretch the piriformis muscle properly. The sciatic nerve runs directly underneath this muscle. When it is tight, it causes constant pressure on the nerve. When I open up these muscles in conjunction with the hip flexors and extensors, the sciatic pain subsides.

#### **Other AIS Muscular Benefits**

Some other examples of muscular ailments that may be alleviated by the AIS technique include shoulder impingement, kyphosis (excessive outward curvature of the T-spine), lordosis (excessive inward curvature of the lumbar spine), arthritis in the hands or feet, frozen shoulder, neck impingements, little to no spinal rotation, scoliosis, bunions, and many more.







#### **BRIDGE TIP OF THE WEEK**

When the Bidding Goes:

1 Club — pass — pass - ?

By Gregg Van Dyke, Bridge Director

When a 1club opening bid is passed to you, keep in mind partner was not strong enough to overcall 1 Club.

When a 1club opening bid is passed to you, look at your club length. If you are short, partner may yet have a good hand. If you have club length, a good chance partner is weak.

1) S- Q4 H- 876 D- KJ76 C-AJ95

2) S- Q98 H-A954 D-KJ87 C- 84

With (1), pass because partner is probably short in clubs and probably weak not to be able to bid at the one level.

Opener probably has the 18-19 point balanced hand and wants to get back into the bidding.

With (2), double your club shortness indicates that partner may have a good hand with clubs after all.




