## TOURNAMENT DETAILS

### GOLF TOURNAMENT

#### SCRAMBLE FORMAT:

The four players that golf must be the four that fish. All players tee off and choose the best ball. From there the group will continue to choose the best shot and play from that location until the ball is holed. Players may place their ball within one club length of the chosen spot, no closer to the hole. If the chosen spot is in the rough, hazard, bunker, etc., the ball must remain within that same condition. Once on the green, the ball may be placed within two inches of the chosen spot, no closer to the hole.

*Note: The Team must use each player's tee shot twice.*

#### HANDICAP:

A team handicap will be established from 10% of each handicap. All handicaps must be verified with a GHIN number; unverified handicaps will result in a 0 handicap. A handicap of 28 is the maximum.

#### SCORING SYSTEM:

The team that posts the lowest net score will set the benchmark by which teams earn points along a sliding scale. For example, if a net 66 is the low round, that team receives 500 points for that score. The next low score will be awarded 450 points, and the next lowest 400 points.

#### BONUS POINTS:

- 15 Points available for Closest to the Hole Contests (Competitions on Holes #5, #9, #11 & #18)
- 15 Points available for Longest Drive Contests (Competitions on Holes #6, #8 #14 #17)

#### TIES:

Will be broken by match of cards. Back nine score, then if still tied, hole by hole from 18.

### FISHING COMPETITION

#### CATCH & RELEASE FORMAT:

The Catch and Release Format is a practice within recreational fishing intended as a technique of conservation. After capture, the fish are unhooked and returned to the water. Only sailfish will count, as they are the target species for this tournament. All tackle and line will be 20# class or lighter. There is no restriction on leader material or weight class as long as leader length does not exceed 15' and the combined length of double line and leader does not exceed 20'. **All I.G.F.A. rules apply**, and leader lengths that comply with LGFA rules. All billfish caught during the tournament must be released. Precautions must be taken in order to ensure to the fullest possibility that the sailfish does not lose its life. **ALL hook-ups, releases and catches MUST be called into the Committee Boat within the last hour of the fishing.**

#### HOURS OF FISHING:

- Lines in: 9:00 am
- Lines out: 4:00 pm

#### HONOR SYSTEM GUIDELINES:

- There are no fishing boundaries, but all boats must depart from and return to the Ocean Reef Club.
- Circle Hooks (4 degree offset or less)
- No Chumming
- No Hook & Hand (Person who engages the fish fights the fish)

#### SCORING:

Fishing Points will be awarded along a sliding scale, 500 points to the team with the most sailfish released, 450 points for second place team, and 400 points for third place team and continues until 200 points.

#### BONUS POINTS\*:

- 25 Points: Dolphin, Wahoo, Kingfi & Tuna
- 75 Points: Marlin
- \*Max (3) fish per species

Score Sheets must be turned into the Dock Office by 5:00pm, even if score is zero.

#### TIES:

Will be broken by time of landing your fish.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

#### DRESS CODE:

No cargo shorts are allowed on the course or at the events. Jackets are optional, no blue jeans, and collared shirts are acceptable.

#### AWARDS:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams in the Golf and Fishing competitions, and to the top team overall.
