## We Mourn the Loss William "Bill" Bahl

Inspiration + Diligence + Hard Work = Success


William Forrest (Bill) Bahl was born March 27, 1951, the son of Charles (Charlie) and Jane Bahl. Bill's relationship and admiration for his father defined the cadence for the rest of his life. Bill and Charlie shared a love of investments, the art of business and a quick wit. The concepts of chasing excellence and legacy were foundational to Bill, as he built both Bahl & Gaynor and his family, the "Bahl Team", the two loves of his life.

Upon graduation from Aiken High School in 1969, Bill traveled south to University of Florida where his ambition was paired with the smile of fate as he met the love of his life, Katherine (Kathy) Connors. Bill and Kathy sprinted through the next two



decades together. Following Bill's graduation in 1972, he earned his MBA from the University of Michigan in 1973.

Bill's investment career began at the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh before returning to Cincinnati to become the Chief Investment Officer at 5/3rd Bank. Bill's final training was as the Chief Investment Officer at Northern Trust in Chicago. Through Bill's early investment career, he was confident in two absolute truths, the power of dividend-



growing equities and alignment of client-advisor interests, both unique views at that time. When Bill encountered Vere Gaynor, the two quickly decided to join forces to found an independent investment advisory firm. In July of 1990, Bahl & Gaynor opened its doors and has since grown to be one of the largest independent registered investment managers in the country.

Bill's impact in the community highlights how he was not only a great leader and competitor, but also a great teammate. Bill served as the President of the Board for Cincinnati Country Day School and the Cincinnati Country Club while also serving as a Board Member for the Deaconess Hospital, Deaconess Associations Incorporated and the Ocean Reef Chapel Foundation. The capstone achievement of Bill's professional ambition and community impact was his selection to the Cincinnati Financial Board of Directors in 1995 and ultimately being appointed Lead Director in 2011.

Running parallel to Bahl & Gaynor was Bill and Kathy's dedication to the "Bahl Team". The "Bahl Team" is known not only for its relentless work ethic and loyalty, but also for its unique sense of humor and love for Top Gun. Bill was an extremely dedicated father and husband who made a priority to never miss a family dinner nor sporting event. Bill and Kathy believed that strengthening family and community is a product of both quality and quantity of time. They achieved this through active family vacations, such

as the HF Bar Ranch, and also setting roots in Hilton Head Island, SC, Ocean Reef, and Georgetown, OH. Bill found great peace during his sunrise walks on the beaches of Sea Pines with his black labs. He loved boating in the waters of Hilton Head and Ocean Reef. Bill and Kathy created deep friendships in Ocean Reef through competitive bridge and the Chapel. Lastly, Bill and Kathy revitalized wildlife artist John Ruthven's farm, Evans Run, in Georgetown, OH. On the Farm, Bill fulfilled his childhood dream of expansive views, gator rides and great conversation with family and friends.

Bill leaves a legacy of entrepreneurship, community impact and family. Bill truly lived the "American Dream". The "Bahl Team" mourns Bill's passing but celebrates his legacy. Bill is survived by his wife of 48 years, Kathy, sister, Martha Grant (Andy), four children, Jeff (Jen), Andrew (Daphne), Emily Salzman (RJ) and John (Kelsey) along with 12 grandchildren, Carson, Taylor, Cameron, Dax, Isabel, Grant, Slater, Nick, Evelyn, Johnny, Margot and Connor. ## Recycling Soap, Saving Lives

"Recycling soap, saving lives." That is the tagline of the Clean the World project – a lifesaving organization that our Lodging Team has participated in for more than 20 years. While Lodging's involvement in this program makes a significant impact every day, this impact hit even closer to home after Hurricane Ian ravaged Ocean Reef's Florida neighbors in Fort Myers.

A global health organization, Clean the World Foundation is committed to improving the quality of life for vulnerable communities around the world. Founded in 2009, they do this by recycling and repurposing discarded hygiene supplies from the hospitality industry. The program provides not




only general hygiene, but also addresses sustainable access to water, sanitation, and feminine hygiene.

The primary way Ocean Reef Club assists in this effort is through Clean the World's soap and bottled amenity recycling program. Associates collect discarded soap bars and plastic amenity bottles from Inn rooms, and package and ship them to Clean the World, which then gives them a second life by distributing the items to people in need. Through these efforts and more, Clean the World, with Ocean Reef Club's help and that of many other hospitality organizations around the globe, was able to provide hygiene kits and access to warm showers for those men, women and children affected by Hurricane Ian in Fort Myers as they look to recover.

The Club is proud to do their part in providing waste and energy solutions that not only benefit the Club as a whole, but also help those less fortunate. The Housekeeping department has even implemented special training into their Associate onboarding process on how to properly collect, package and ship waste to organizations like Clean the World.

Over the course of the past few years, the Lodging department has collected 11,741 pounds of waste and 7,188 pounds of plastic. They donated more than 4,500 pounds of soap to the Clean the World organization, which led to the distribution of 26,286 bars of soap and provided 468 hygiene kits. 



## A Bonefish Bonnie's Remarkable Fish Story from the Seychelles

Bonnie **Diane Hill** and her husband **Keith** recently returned from a trip they "won" at the All Charities auction a few years ago, during Covid. The Seychelles' Alphonse Lodge was nice enough to honor their spot a year late, and Diane reports, "It's a beautiful lodge, really a paradise spot in the middle of the ocean."

Diane goes on to describe a once-in-a-lifetime catch:

"The Seychelles are an amazing fishery, completely pristine, with zero commercial pressure since the islands are so far removed from any populated area. In addition to the unbelievable bonefish population, they have some unique fish

species that can be caught on flies. There are GTs (Giant Trevally), several species of shallow water trigger fish and a fish called a milkfish (see photo).

"The milkfish, only found in the Pacific and Indian Oceans, is named for its milky white color and is very unusual in that it is a vegetarian fish, eating only the patches of algal sea grass in the shallows. It is the last of an extinct species of the family Chanidae. Because these fish are vegetarians, they are very difficult to catch and will usually ignore any kind of fly."

Adding to the challenge,

Diane notes, "And they have no teeth."

She goes on to explain, "The only time they will take a fly is when they are schooling and feeding on the surface with their mouths half out of the water, an extremely rare occurrence. I lucked into one of those feeding schools while we were fishing one morning, and my guide had the fly they make at Alphonse lodge that resembles a piece of algae. It still took about 100 casts. About one in 10 casts had a taker, but the set has to be perfect, and they immediately leap in the air to spit the hook. I caught this one just as the feeding school

was dispersing. It's the first milkfish caught at the lodge this year. Fought a bit like a small tarpon."

She concludes, "Anyway, hope you enjoyed my fish story. The Seychelles are a long way to go, but the lodge is amazing and the fishery is unreal."

Other new offerings include a monthly tennis 105 tournament, U-40 Croquet and Cocktail event, and daily Pickleball Advanced Organized Play.



## SHORP! What **Does it Stand** For?

"Pickleball Tip" by Frank Ngo, **Pickleball Professional** 

Successful strategy in pickleball is forcing your opponent to hit a "pop-up" with a ball that is non-attackable. How? For this I will use the acronym "SHORP". It stands for Soft Hands. Offensive Reset, Placement.

1.Soft Hands: Develop a dinking game and various degrees of power. Use patience and the neutral zones consistently.

2.Offensive Reset: Develop effective third shot and midcourt drops. Ability to move through the transitional zone effectively.

**3.Placement:** Create open space by manipulating an opponent's balance. Use proper angles, neutral zones and red zone balls.

#### **Soft Hands Equals Great Dinking**

Developing a strong dinking game is tougher than one thinks. It can also be incredibly frustrating but it is paramount to breaking down your opponent mentally. There's nothing more defeating than

the feeling after losing a dink war. But winning it will keep a team with the cutting edge. The reason it is tough is because it uses the virtue of patience and the ability to think a couple shots ahead, like chess.

#### **Offensive Resets Are Power Plays**

The purpose of resetting is to transition a team offensively towards the kitchen to engage into a dink battle in an attempt to move the other team

backwards and use the open areas of the court to end the point.

#### **Placement Controls An Opponent**

A well-placed ball has the ability to throw an opponent completely off balance in order to force an error or to create open space for an easy put-away shot.

Placement, soft hands, and degree of power work together as a trifecta.

## Bridge Tip of the Week **Bidding Judgment**

#### **Priorities**

When deciding on the final contract, your priorities are: 1. 8-card or longer major fit.

2. Notrump if both hands are balanced or nearly balanced.

3. Playing in a minor.

#### **Choosing the Better Fit**

If you have a fit with both majors (or both minors) play in the fit that is more evenly divided in both hands. Long suits can be used to discard losers.

With 2 potential losers in both minors, a spade contract will not give you the ability to get rid of a club loser. However in hearts, you can use your good spades in the West hand to get rid of the clubs in the East hand.

**Exception:** When a suit is extremely strong (6+ cards with KQJ or better) or extremely long (7+), then that suit should be trump.

#### **Minor Suit Contracts**

Sometimes Notrump is not a desired contract when vou have a hand that could be disastrous. If you have a 9-card minor fit, lack of

honors in the sides and singletons or voids, then you might want to think about playing in a minor suit.

#### **Other Pointers**

• If partner bids your short

suit, it reduces the value of your hand.

• If the opponents bids your long suit, it also reduces the value of your hand.

• High cards in your partner's suit increases the value of your hand.

• High cards (except the Ace) in your opponent's suit decreases the value of your hand.

• Intermediate cards (tens, nines and eights) add extra value in notrump contracts.


