Rules Reminder at Your Club The "Two Visit Rule"

A longstanding rule set in place to ensure membership in Ocean Reef Club would always be a privilege, is the "Two Visit Rule." Below is the explanation as written in the Club's Rules & Regulations.

1.No person, other than a house guest, or child of a Club member, as set forth herein in the sections entitled "Guests" and "Children," shall be permitted to visit the Club more than two times in any five year period, with each visit to be limited to a maximum of 14 days, without becoming a member of the Club. This shall be known as the "two visit rule."

2. The two visit rule will apply to guests staying in rooms at the Inn, other than sponsored group attendees, as well as to boat owners using the Club's marina.

3. The two visit rule will apply to those clubs granted reciprocity or other affiliation with the Club.

When the two visit rule applies to boats and yachts, the owner of the vessel will be registered as the visitor. All guests on board the vessel will also be registered as guests of the Club if operationally feasible to do so.

As a reminder, sponsoring members are responsible for the conduct of their guests. If the manner, deportment or appearance of any guests is deemed to be unsatisfactory, the sponsoring member shall, at the request of the Club cause such guests to leave the Club.



We Mourn the Loss Bob Baal

Robert G. (Bob) Baal, longtime Baptist Health Ambassador to Ocean Reef and the Medical Center, passed away after a brief illness on November 3, 2022.

Bob and his wife of 61 years, Ruth, first came to The Reef in the mid-eighties and became official Members at the buyout in 1992. They have lived at Pumpkin Key, Diana Road and, most recently, the Residence Club.

It was in 1992 that Bob transitioned from Board Chairman of Baptist Health Foundation to its Chief Executive Officer, a position he held until 2009. Working closely with The Reef leadership, and, in particular, Tom Davidson, they established the Ocean Reef/Baptist Health Advisory Board, and



the Ad Hoc Committee on Philanthropy.

Through these channels, the Ocean Reef membership provided critical support for such projects as the first Ocean Reef big philanthropic, initiative helping fund, the new Homestead Hospital building, as well as the Emergency Evacuation Helipad, the MCVI Stroke Center, and the Miami Cancer Institute, all on the Baptist Hospital campus. In addition, there are nearly 500 Baptist Health Giving Society members at Ocean Reef. Bob was deeply involved in all these endeavors.

Bob was born in New York City to Louise (Beisler) and Robert A. Baal, in 1928. He was educated at Concordia Prep in Bronxville, New York and earned his Bachelor's degree at Bates College in Maine. From 1950 to 1952, he served in the Army Security Agency, now NSA. He started his business career in broadcasting working for CBS, NBC, ABC and Westinghouse as a broadcast time sales executive. In 1970 Bob and Ruth and their three children moved from Greenwich, Connecticut to Miami, Florida, where Bob became National Sales Manager at WTVJ/Channel 4.

In 1972, Bob transitioned to commercial real estate, eventually forming the Baal Realty Group. This led to his longtime involvement with the Baptist Health Foundation. It also brought him to WPBT/ Channel 2, public television in South Florida. He joined that board in 1979, chaired their Executive Committee and was their Board Chairman in 1984/1985. In 2014, he received WPBT's Lifetime Service Award.

Bob and Ruth have three children: Robin (Panethere), Bob Jr., and Perri (Yearwood); and eight grandchildren: Luke Yearwood, Kyla Baal, Drew Panethere, Olivia Yearwood, Alexa Baal, Katherine and Lindsay Panethere, and Kohl Yearwood. All have experienced many wonderful occasions while visiting Bob and Ruth at The Reef.

Bob led a full life and leaves behind a legacy of great memories, true friends, and a loving wife and family. Our community, and the world, has lost another good one.

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What Can We Ever Say to You?

The young man across the table from me was severely disfigured. He had extensive facial burns, no nose, and no hair. Parts of his hands were missing. He was in his early twenties. He was a Marine. He suffered his wounds serving our country in the war on terror.

Our church in Ketchum, Idaho was hosting an event for a local organization, Higher Ground. Twice each year, once in the summer and once in the winter, Higher Ground brings wounded vets and their spouses to the Sun Valley area. Support from the community funds the entire cost of these annual two-week trips.

In winter, you can see vets schussing down the slopes of Baldy, Sun Valley's local mountain. Some are on skis, and others on adaptive ski equipment. They're having a ball. In the summers, they spread out across the local streams and ponds in pursuit of trout with a fly rod.

That night, I looked at that young Marine and asked, "What can we ever say to you that is adequate to recognize what you have endured in service to our country?" His sharp eyes met mine. "Try thank you," he said, with no edge of bitterness or self-pity in his voice.

I have often thought about that exchange, and especially his answer to my question. It has prompted reflection about all those twenty-somethings who have served our nation faithfully through and beyond the more than seven decades I've been alive.

My dad was one of those in World War II. He was a radarman on board a destroyer, the USS Mullany. He was a 'plank holder,' an original crew member who took it out on the first sea trials. He narrowly missed being killed when a kamikaze took out the forward gun turret in the fighting off Okinawa. He suffered no outward visible wounds. But like many from that era, he was never able to talk about the emotional scars he suffered from the horror he witnessed in the aftermath of the attack. Thirty-one of his friends were killed, and eighteen never accounted for.

This summer, I conducted the memorial service for Miner Harkness. Miner was our neighbor in Sun Valley. He and his wife Sarah became great friends. For many years, he headed the Sierra Madre Search and Rescue organization in Southern California. He proudly served in the Army in Korea, fighting in some of the bloodiest battles in brutal, winter conditions. My favorite picture of Miner is of his smiling face, wearing his everpresent Korean Vet ball cap.

During the Vietnam War, the vets who served honorably were treated like pariah on their return home. One whom I was privileged to know was Gerald 'Jerry' Coffee. He flew the reconnaissance mission over Cuba that discovered the Russian missiles. It was a Russian missile that destroyed his jet flying over North Vietnam. He was one of those who spent more than seven years in what was euphemistically known as the 'Hanoi Hilton.' He tells the story in his book, "Beyond Survival."

Years ago, a member of my staff was a Marine Recon captain in Vietnam. His missions boggled my mind. What I will never forget him telling me was, "Bob, I'll never have an experience of comradery like that I experienced in the war."

Maybe you're like me. I've never served in the military. Our children were born at a time when none of the three were called to serve. But like me, each of them and their children owe a debt of gratitude to those who have. We all do.

What can we say to them on this Veterans Day Weekend? Try, "thank you." We're going to do that this Sunday, in the worship service of the Protestant Congregation at 9 a.m. in the Chapel and Fellowship Center at Ocean Reef. Come and join us as we say "thank you" together, to them, and to God for them.

Tropical breezes, soothing music, great drinks, and a gathering of friends as the lounge filled up. In the space of a few hours, Ocean Reef wrapped us in its intoxicating spell. Yes, almost magic.



Tyler said, "We do not miss the two hour traffic jams that we experienced in Arlington. My all time, favorite time here on The Reef is taking my boys to school in a golf cart. 



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Pickleball Tip of the Week Maintain Your Ready Position

One of the most important aspects of your pickleball game is your ready position while at the kitchen line. Being prepared and having the ability to anticipate can really elevate your game quickly. Here are some tips for having a successful ready position at the kitchen line:

1. Have a wide base and keep your feet outside of your shoulders. This allows you to stay low and eliminates extra unwanted movement. 2. Have your body weight forward with your knees bent. Leaning into the court allows you to be more aggressive and take

more balls out of the air to keep

3. Have your paddle up slightly favoring your backhand and your arms out in front of you. This allows for great defense for when your opponent decides to speed it up. A lot of times your opponent will "accidentally" hit your paddle as long as your able to keep it up and out in front.

Always assume that your opponent is going to speed the ball up at you...if they decide to hit a dink you will have plenty of reaction time to handle their shot. The more you stay in your ready position, the more it becomes muscle memory, so always stay ready whenever you are up at the kitchen line whether you are warming up with friends, drilling, or playing competitive pickleball!

1430 is a popular keycard asking convention to find out the number of keycards partner has in his hand.

Keycards

There are 5 Keycards. All 4 Aces and the King of Trump.
4NT is the asking bid.
The responses are:

 $5 \stackrel{\bullet}{•} = 1 \text{ or } 4 \text{ Keycards } (14)$ $5 \stackrel{\bullet}{•} = 0 \text{ or } 3 \text{ Keycards } (30)$ $5 \stackrel{\bullet}{•} = 2 \text{ or } 5 \text{ Keycards without}$ the Queen of Trump $5 \stackrel{\bullet}{•} = 2 \text{ or } 5 \text{ Keycards with}$ the Queen of Trump

Voids

•5NT = Even Number of Keycards (2 or 4) with a useful void.
•6 level of void suit = Odd Number of Keycards (1 or 3), bidding the void suit.
•6 level of trump suit = Odd Number of Keycards (1 or 3) with a useful void in a suit above trump.

Queen Ask

Sometimes we need to find out if partner has the Queen of Trump if partner does not response 5♥ or 5♠. If the 4NT initiator bids the next available suit that is not trump, he is asking if partner has the Queen of Trump.

Example:

1♥-4NT; 5♣-5♦ = Queen Asking. Rebid Response 5♥ = No, 5 ♠ = Yes 1♥-4NT; 5♣-5♦ = Queen Asking. Rebid Response 5♥ = No, 5 ♠ = Yes 1♠-4NT; 5♦-5♥ = Queen Asking. Rebid Response 5♠ = No, 5NT = Yes

Important Guidelines

Do not bid slam if you are missing 2 keycards.
Do not bid slam if you are missing 1 keycard and the Trump Queen



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
