

Gotta Question?

From an early age, we were taught about the safety of walking facing traffic, yet I see many people walk with their backs to the traffic. What is recommended at Ocean Reef?

The following was pulled from a January 15, 2016 Ocean Reef Press article by Jim Leenhouts on walking safety, "...the overriding rule for walkers using Ocean Reef streets is defensive walking...Walk against the traffic in your walking lane. Look at what is coming at you... Assure yourself the driver sees you. Because you are walking against vehicle traffic, be aware that drivers entering a street from a driveway or side street in front of you typically look left (away from you) for their final opening before moving – often starting quickly and turning right toward you... Do not cross in front of the vehicle..."

That being said, Ocean Reef does have several areas designated as paved walking paths (see the map below), which can be walked on in either direction, and even some mixed-use paths where walkers travel alongside cart paths.




When traveling on mixeduse paths, be sure to follow the painted cart of pedestrian symbols indicating what lane to walk in. In these cases, pedestrians use the outside lane, closest to the road.



Overall, the most important things you can do are become an aware walker, walk against traffic when on the road, and follow painted symbols on cart and walking paths. If you have more questions on safety, contact Public Safety at 305-367-2222.

Continued from | 1 partners if they are delayed. The vibe occasionally extends to the dining room, although it is still quieter than other venues."

I decided I needed to take Fair Patricia for a test drive. As you may know, I am not really much of a fish person. I gravitate to cheese, meat, poultry, potatoes, and pasta. Oh sure, some fish dishes are irresistible: Ocean Reef Yellowtail Classic; Dover Sole Meuniere (I am a sucker for butter); the Turbot Chef Jonathan has added to the CH Prime menu this year (the sauce is so good you will chase any residue with a spoon), or anything Chef Eric creates at the Sushi Bar. But I am determined to broaden my horizons.

As we were seated, I remembered the wonderful (huge) Berkshire Pork Chop from last year. I found it was carried over to the new menu, which is a mix of favorites from the Raw Bar, the Islander, and Ocean Room specialties.

There are the same fresh fish as the Islander, and a full service Sushi Bar in the front of the room. Impressive. Mister "Big Personality" turned out to be Nico DiPerna, the new Ocean Room Manager. His girlfriend persuaded him to move south from Palm Beach where he managed the Morton's Steak House (she teaches Marine Science at the Ocean Studies Charter School in Key Largo. Never under estimate girlfriends. We are lucky for her pluck). In three minutes, it felt like we had known Nico

for years. That's talent. By the way, his first job at eight years old was busing tables in his Uncle's diner.

Our favorite server from last year, Ana Suerte, has returned. She helped it feel like a reunion. As did Chef de Cuisine Ryan Schmidt and Sous Chef Michael Meadows who were generous with their time and enthusiasm about the menu. They and the staff are focusing on three pillars – Elevated Cuisine, Genuine Hospitality, Accessible Elegance. We felt they are

delivering.

The Ocean Room offers six "Signature Preparations" for each of the six fresh fish. They say they are "composed dishes" rather than simply different sauces. I took the plunge. Black Grouper with the "Au Poivre" preparation (crispy marble potato, parsnip puree, Cognac [!], Fig jus). Quite delightful. Patricia had the Ora King Salmon, fresh from New Zealand (Chef Eric's find) -- known among chefs as the "Wagyu of Salmon" for its marbling and buttery texture. She paired it with the "Oscar" preparation (King Crab meat, Green and White Asparagus, Tomato Confit, Hollandaise). "Terrific," she pronounced, "Moist and flavorful with a crispy skin. Just right."

We sighed. We smiled. We lingered, contented, but thinking of Winston waiting back home. He would be straining to hear any faint sign of our return. A happy Date Night ended with an overjoyed dog running in circles.

Thanks for the tip Fiona & Randy. The Ocean Room is open daily for breakfast, and nightly Tuesday through Saturday.

Dining reservations can be made any time of day by using the Club's reservation system via oceanreef.com/ Dining. Browse availability for Islander, Gianni, Ocean Room and CH Prime without picking up the phone. Log in, navigate to the Dining page and click "Reservation" under the restaurant you wish to reserve. Then simply input your desired date, time and number of guests, and select! You will receive a confirmation via email that includes information on the new cancellation policy as

well as the dress code.

Please note these closures are required by FAA regulations and will be enforced by the USCG and FWC. Any violation of these areas by a boat will force an immediate stoppage of the show. MAKING HISTORY

A Vintage **Tradition** is Born

The following was excerpted from the Ocean Reef Club history book, On the Reef, written by Shirley Shipley and the late **Dick Farmer**.

The weeks between Thanksgiving and Christmas were traditionally slow at Ocean Reef and the board began searching ways to attract business for this period. Coincidentally, one summer weekend after the 1993 Member buyout, Vicki and Alan Goldstein were walking the docks at the Great Harbor Marina in Southwest Harbor, Maine, when they realized a classic yacht show was in progress. While admiring beautiful old boats, they were struck by the fact that after lavishing thousands of dollars to restore these yachts, the owners

were so eager to show them off to others that they would pay to put them in a show.

With this kernel of an idea, the question remained whether or not this could work at Ocean Reef Club. There were no shortage of classic yachts in Maine but in Florida, beautifully restored true classic boats might be hard to find. Would Ocean Reef be able to attract enough boats to put on a credible show? Would boat owners actually pay for their

"room and board" so Ocean Reef could afford the show? And when should Ocean Reef have such a show? It seemed that a classic boat show would fit nicely in the slump between Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Retuning to Ocean Reef, Vicki Goldstein began her research and learned there were indeed an abundance of classic boats either in Florida or passing through whose owners were eager to show them off. Using her connections in the yachting industry and anywhere else she could think of, Vicki launched the first Vintage Weekend in 1994.

The second year, Ocean Reef member and car collector Bill Raithel recruited friends and fellow car enthusiasts to bring their vintage automobiles. One of them, Bill Parfet, in turn enticed Ron Elenbaas and Bill Johnston to bring their cars. The three men became a driving force in the success of Vintage Weekend.

On the Aviation side, Denny Moore, who was the Ocean Reef airport manager at the time, recruited aviators from nearby air shows to participate. Eventually, member Lenny Sikora, who had participated for many years, took the reins on the aviation part of the show in 2008.

Of course, the Vintage Weekend would not be possible without the goodwill of the Ocean Reef community, which annual endure noise, gas and diesel fumes, and hubbub. Many members give up marina slips, marina parking, and landing slots at the airport for the weekend. None of it would have happened without the help of Ocean Reef Club associates and management.

So here we are for the 26th year, welcoming vintage yachts, automobiles and aircraft in a way only Ocean Reef Club can do. Thank you to the innovators, supporters, exhibitors and attendees who continue to celebrate this incredible tradition.

Emergency Call Boxes Installed Throughout the Club

Over the summer, the Club made efforts to make Buccaneer Island an even safer place for Members and their families to enjoy. Previously, a handheld phone located by the Pool Desk was used in the case of an emergency. That phone was removed and replaced with five brand new emergency call boxes designated throughout the pool and beach areas.

In an effort to create greater widespread communication across all of The Reef in the case of an emergency, these same boxes have now been installed in the Marina Fitness Center and at the Croquet Courts as well. These boxes are an increasingly more

reliable and accessible resource when faced with an emergency. They run on multiple cell service bands, are monitored 24/7 with a live emergency services dispatcher, and have a backup battery built in.

Whenever help is needed, the requester will push the button in the middle of the box, located under "PUSH TO CALL", and emergency services will be contacted immediately. Once the button is pushed and the emergency phone is activated, detailed location information will be relayed to Public Safety so


EMS knows the exact location to respond to the emergency.

- 2. Snapper Pool by ice machine
- 3. The Point

- 4. Beach Activities Hut
- 5. Marlin Beach by ice machine
- 6. Marina Fitness Center near gym entry
- 7. Croquet Courts in the middle of the shelter

Membership Rules & Waitlist Update

As the Club continues to prioritize the Member experience and put Members first, changes have been made with regard to how guests of Social and Legacy Members will be able to visit Ocean Reef Club.

Announced at November's Town Hall meeting, beginning December 1, 2022, all guests must be accompanied by the sponsoring Social or Legacy member. This applies to both day guests or those guests enjoying overnight accommodations.

Whether arriving by land, sea or air, a maximum of six guests, including lineal family, can accompany a Social or Legacy member for the day. When sponsoring family and friends to enjoy overnight accommodations, the sponsoring

member must be staying overnight for the same time period. Guests are still afforded the opportunity to stay twice in a five-year period for up to 14 days per visit.

As a reminder, sponsoring Members are responsible for the decorum and behavior of their guests, including adherence to all Club rules.



Christmas Happenings!

Early December in the mountains of Idaho bears no resemblance to early December in the Florida Keys. Reflecting on 50 Years of USCG Auxiliary Service


In December 2022, Ocean Reef Flotilla 13-04 of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary will celebrate the 50th Anniversary of its 1972 founding. Ocean Reef Members should celebrate with them.

The founding Flotilla members were a small group of well experienced Ocean Reef boaters, who had military experience or, in many cases, were involved in civilian boating activities often related to military or commercial boating efforts.

The founders shared a strong sense that the Ocean Reef boating area of hidden reefs, strong and often adverse currents, limited navigation aids, and a lack of prompt rescue service created a beautiful yet dangerous boating environment that is especially challenging for new boaters without tropical water weather experience and navigation skills.

Luckily, structure for a local organization to provide help had been created by defense-oriented Congressional action in 1939 when, shortly before WWII, Congress created the US Coast Guard Reserve and then, in 1941, expanded and renamed it The United States Coast Guard Auxiliary. The action included civilian members to be organized into local "Flotillas", each administered by the 13 Divisions of the US Coast Guard.

Flotillas were primarily



responsible for supporting boating safety objectives of the US Coast Guard and also included the use of Flotilla members' boats as search and rescue and training vessels. The Flotilla's responsibilities were public education, local vessel examination for required safety equipment, monitoring the condition and placement of navigation aids, boosting boat registration standards and, where needed, undertaking non-lawenforcing duties and activities at US Coast Guard Stations. Flotilla members were required to meet the standards of regular US Coast Guard personnel, and were responsible for their own training and testing of members.

As the Ocean Reef Flotilla is closely associated with the Coast Guard Station in Islamorada, each Flotilla around the country is associated with a particular Coast Guard Station that would either authorize or request all local missions in its area and require reporting its activities to the Officer on Duty.

Encouragement in organizing a Flotilla at Ocean Reef came from both United States Coast Guard Stations at Islamorada and Miami located 60 miles apart which "bracket" Ocean Reef. Each station has a 30 mile, 4 hour boating service gap, covering an especially incident-active, narrow, reef impacted area that had grown exponentially in boating use. The

Flotilla at Ocean Reef was tasked to monitor and patrol this gap area.

On December 12, 1972, Flotilla 13-04 was established and then incorporated in 1976 so as to properly own, operate and insure its first Search and Rescue and Training Mission vessel, the RH Coleman. There were three successive vessels that were purchased over the years by donations from grateful Ocean Reef Members. All boats have since been able to retire for a lack of local emergency missions. Many Flotilla members have become qualified to use their own qualified vessels as Operational Facilities for rescue missions, Coast Guard member training, regular navigation marker condition inventory, and more.

Based on the remarkable reduction of Ocean Reef missions for rescue over 50 years, the hopes of the Founding Members seemed to have been achieved and boating is now a joyful and much safer part of life at Ocean Reef. The Flotilla has grown from 5 far-sighted originals to 15 first members and almost 90 members in the middle '90s. Formal classroom boating education courses are now offered for Ocean Reef Members, boating safety articles are published in the Ocean Reef Press, and a "Safe Boating Day" extravaganza is well attended every year on the Thursday before Easter. Free vessel examinations and instruction

in the use and ease of advanced electronic navigation aids have all played a role in increased boating safety awareness at Ocean Reef. Though the reach of Flotilla 13-04 extends out beyond just Ocean Poof

Using Ocean Reef Flotilla crews and vessels, Miami USCG helicopters can train to drop rescue swimmers to the Flotilla target boat or lower baskets to the boat as part of the training for helo squadrons. The Ocean Reef Flotilla had the distinction of doing this at night, and became the only Flotilla in the Florida Keys that was authorized by the USCG to do so! This success bred more training of other fellow Keys flotillas, USCG Stations and support at Ocean Reef. The Ocean Reef Flotilla began to share their crew and coxswains with the adjoining Upper Keys Flotilla 13-08, increasing the number of missions for the entire Upper

After 50 years, it seems that the Congressional mandate to "support" the US Coast Guard mission of public safe boating is undiluted and the Flotilla concept remains, by our Ocean Reef standards, a vibrant success, hinging on Ocean Reef support and member dedication.



The oily flesh is excellent for smoking, but also good as sashimi or freshly grilled. Mutton Snapper or Kingfish, even if yours is not the winning catch, you will still have a delicious dinner for

yourselves and your neighbors.

TENNIS TIP

Tennis Tip of the Week:

Mix & Match Your Serves



by Carolina Quevedo, Tennis & Pickleball Concierge

The serve is the only stroke in tennis that you have control over. From the start, you get to decide how you want to play your opponent - serve and go to the net, serve wide to force your opponent off the court, serve to the "T" to keep your opponent from hitting an angled return, and so on. Being able to mix and match your serves will keep your opponents on their toes and keep your game indecipherable.

Here are some tips to improve your serve:

First, you need to make sure that your service motion is repeatable. This starts with your ball toss and requires your contact point to be similar on each serve. The toss is a key component, and it takes a lot of practice to figure out what works best for you, your body, your motion, and your timing. When practicing your serve toss, be sure to keep your arm long and straight. Bending the elbow and too much flick of the wrist causes the toss to be erratic. Also be certain to release the ball at the top of your service motion. Letting go of the ball too low causes your toss to float away from you again causing toss inconsistencies.

Second, your in-match decisions will often dictate your serve percentages. Depending on how you feel on a given day, you should be choosing serves that you are more comfortable with in order to get that serve in to start the point.

Finally, and most importantly, you need to be putting in the necessary repetitions to improve your serve and keep it sharp. If you are interested on working on your serve with me, call the Tennis Pro Shop at 305-367-6583 to book a lesson

BRIDGE TIP

Basic 2-Over-1 Principles & **Definitions**

2-over-1 forcing-to-game is "on" only when your side opens 1 \blacklozenge or 1 v or 1 in 1st or 2nd seat and the next player passes and responder makes a nonjump bid of 2 of a new suit.

The only relevant auctions are:



1 ♦ -2 ♣ can be used to show an opening hand and might include a 4-card major.

Example:

- ♠ KQxx **V**Jx Kx
- AQxxx

2-over-1 meanings are "off" when:

- Opener is in 3rd or 4th seat. A passed hand cannot force to game.
- Your opponent (responder's RHO) makes an overcall or double. In competition, all of responder's bids revert to their standard meanings:
- After an intervening overcall, responder's newsuit bid shows a long suit and decent values, but it is not forcing to game. It could be as few as 8-9 pts if you have a strong suit.
- After an intervening double, responder's 2-level bid of a new suit is weak (5-9 pts.).
- After an overcall or a double, a 1NT response is standard (7-10 pts. with a stopper) and is not forcing.
- Redouble should be used to show 10+ points after an intervening double.

Game level is defined as 3NT or 4 of a suit. If your trump suit is a major, the "4-of-a-suit" agreement will get you to game. Note, though, that if your trump suit is a minor, you are not forced all the way to 5 ♣ or 5 \leftrightarrow . Even if you've made a 2-over-1 response, your auction can end at $4 \clubsuit$ or $4 \diamondsuit$ if that's your agreed suit.

A 2-over-1 response is just one of the ways you can show game values.

Playing the 2-over-1 system does not affect the meanings of other auctions. One-level responses (1 \(\forall \cdot -1 \lefta \) and direct raises of partner's suit (single, limit and forcing) have the same meanings as in standard bidding. Other conventions and treatments -- Weak Jump Shifts, Bergen Raises, Jacoby 2NT, Splinter Bids, New Minor Forcing, etc. -can be included in your 2-over-1 system with no modifications.






