PHILANTHROPY MATTERS

Join the ORCF Effort to Provide Humanitarian Relief to Israel

In response to a wave of Member outreach in the days following the October 7 terrorist attacks, the Ocean Reef Community Foundation Israel Relief Fund was established to demonstrate solidarity with and provide humanitarian relief to Israel through US-based nonprofit organizations.

ORCF Chairman **Bill Nutt** emphasized, "This is certainly

about the funding, but it is not all about the funding. It's about saying something loudly of our support for Israel, and finding a meaningful way to benefit those who have been so badly harmed, in spirit as well as physically."

He notes that when there is a crisis outside the scope of our local All Charities effort, such as the disasters in Haiti that touched so many Ocean Reef employee families, the Foundation steps up to offer Members a thoughtful and effective way to respond.

The Foundation is working alongside the interfaith community of Chapel congregations to create such a response. In this case, it is a conduit for the community to show support for Israel and our friends and neighbors in the local Jewish congregation, who are so deeply personally impacted.

The Israel Relief Fund administered by the Foundation Executive Committee will benefit a slate of well-established, highly credible and expert relief organizations, which may change as needs evolve.

Initial partners include the Greater Miami Jewish Federation Israel Emergency Fund, which is prioritizing basic needs for impacted families, the elderly and homebound; cash grants for critical supplies; emergency medical services, supplies and equipment; evacuation assistance for communities under fire; and trauma relief for first responders, the injured and families whose relatives were directly impacted.

Many members will recognize another partner, The Isaiah Project, and its leader -- former head of Christian-Judeo Relations for Israel and frequent guest at the Ocean Reef Chapel, David Nekrutman. The organization is on the ground helping in communities near the Gaza border directly impacted by missile attacks with basic needs, evacuation assistance, emergency response trauma packages,

mourners' tents and protective gear for first responders.

A third initial partner is the American Friends of Magen David Adom, the Israeli equivalent of the Red Cross, which operates blood drives and supports medical first responders providing lifesaving treatment in the midst of rocket attack and gunfire.

Israel: We Need to Pay Attention

My dog and I walked across the Sunrise Cay Bridge just as morning was breaking. A bank of dark gray clouds hung low over the water on the horizon. Wisps of white cirrus clouds and jet contrails laced the sky overhead. The tranquility was interrupted only by the quiet footfall of a jogger passing by.

As we walked, my mind went to another place where gray clouds hang low over the horizon. Wisps of contrails lace the sky. But these clouds are the dark clouds of war hanging low over Gaza. The contrails are from missiles launched in Gaza, raining down death and terror on cities and towns in Israel.

The border between Israel and Gaza has never been a place of tranquility. But what took place on Saturday, October 7th can only be compared with the genocidal acts of the Third Reich in the Holocaust. The barbarous acts carried out by Hamas terrorists on Jews for being Jews, were acts of pure evil.

To most of us, what took place seems inconceivable. That's why it is important to pay attention to the stated rationale that gave rise to these murderous actions.

Bruce Hoffman, writing in "The Atlantic," published an article titled, "Understanding Hamas's Genocidal Ideology: A Close Read of Hamas's Founding Documents." He summarized the 36 documents of the Hamas charter under four main points. They call for:

1. The complete destruction

of Israel as an essential condition for the liberation of Palestine and the establishment of a theocratic state based on Islamic law (Sharia),

- 2. The need for both unrestrained and unceasing holy war (jihad) to attain the above objective,
- 3. The deliberate disdain for, and dismissal of, any negotiated resolution or political settlement of Jewish and Muslim claims to the Holy Land, and
- 4. The reinforcement of historical anti-Semitic tropes and calumnies married to sinister conspiracy theories.

What took place on October 7th can only be understood considering the aims stated in the

Hamas charter. The horror inflicted that day was an intentional murderous act of iihad.

One of my close friends is an experienced Clinical Psychologist, with whom I had lunch regularly. He shared some of the terrible things he has dealt with in his practice. In reflection, he said to me, "If someone tells you they are going to kill you, pay attention!"

One person who knows Hamas is Mosab Hassan Yousef. He is the son of the founder of Hamas. He turned his back on his father's movement and became a spy for Israel. In his journey, he has become a follower of Jesus. We need to pay attention to what he says.

He told an interviewer, "I was born at the heart of Hamas leadership... and I know them very well. They don't care for the Palestinian people. They do not regard human life. I saw their brutality firsthand back in 1996 when I spent about a year and a half in Megiddo Prison... They killed so many Palestinian people at that point, and this is when I decided that I cannot be together with this movement."

Sincere people are protesting Israel's actions in Gaza. But there can be no moral equivalence between the evil perpetrated by Hamas terrorists on the Jewish people in the land, and Israel's legitimate right and duty to defend its nation and its people.

Most everyone is deeply troubled and deeply moved by these horrific events. The one thing we cannot do is be indifferent. We must now be resolutely willing to stand shoulder-to-shoulder with Israel, our ally, and the only democratic government in the Middle East, against this malignant existential threat

I encourage you to use whatever influence you possess to speak on Israel's behalf in any way you can. I encourage you to support humanitarian relief efforts. To that end, we have coordinated with the Ocean Reef Community Foundation on creating the Israel Relief Fund (More information on how to take part can be found on page 4). I encourage you to pray.

We can pray for the victims of these atrocities – the families, loved ones and friends of those brutally slaughtered; and for the some 200 hostages being held captive in Gaza.

We can pray for those tasked with the horrendous work of dealing with the physical and emotional aftermath of the atrocities.

We can pray for the success of the IDF as they seek to destroy the monsters of Hamas. We pray for the protection of all those who live in the God-given homeland of the Jewish people. We can pray for the peace of Jerusalem.

We can pray for the innocents who are caught up in the conflict – those Palestinians, Christians and Jews who hate what is taking place and who simply want to live their lives in peace.

Finally, we can pray for the coming of the only true and lasting hope for peace in the Middle East and in our world. That hope is found in Isaiah's vision of God's Messiah, who will someday "...judge between the nations and will settle disputes for many peoples. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anvmore."

Every morning sunrise brings us one day closer to that day.





Get Ready for the Season: Mandatory Golf Cart Registration Bolsters Roadway Safety

With the busy season on the horizon, ORCA Public Safety reminds residents of the mandatory golf cart registration policy that bolsters safety on our roadways. This straightforward, quick process provides a speed-rated decal to facilitate easy cart identification and appropriate





The red sticker represents fast carts which can go 18 mph or more. The blue sticker represents fast carts which can go a maximum of 17 mph.

use. Registration also helps Public Safety locate your vehicle should someone mistakenly take the wrong cart.

A red sticker is assigned to fast carts, which can go 18 mph or more. Golf carts with red stickers can use either roadways or designated cart lanes but must maintain a speed of 17 mph or slower while in a cart lane. As a reminder, the maximum speed throughout Ocean Reef is 25 mph, with traffic


signs specifically noting any 15-mph zones.

Slower carts with a maximum speed of 17 mph receive a blue sticker and must drive on cart paths. Children driving with a Public Safety permit may ONLY drive designated slow carts. The clear designation of what carts can use which travel paths promotes smooth traffic flow and safety.

To ensure Public Safety has accurate records, please notify the department when

selling your cart or acquiring a new one.

For your convenience, Public Safety offers complimentary home visits to register your golf cart. Where Everyone is Welcome

Michael Cardone, chairman of the Ocean Reef Chapel Foundation, describes the upcoming season's message for the Fellowship Center in one word: *Harmony*.

With the escalating conflict in the Middle East, the independently-run non-profit Ocean Reef Chapel & Fellowship Center serves more than ever as a worship hub for everyone regardless of religious or political affiliation.

"We are all together here, we are all one here, you can feel it,"

said **Jeannie Schiavone** referring to the connection she has to her fellow Chapel members of different denominations. "It's the way it ought to be, the way the world should be."

One of only a handful of its kind, The Chapel is home to four separate congregations under one roof, Catholic, Episcopal, Jewish, and Protestant. It is a center of respite, prayer, celebration, reflection, renewal, legacy, and community, open to both Ocean Reef Members and Associates.

At least two community-wide programs are scheduled for the 2023-2024 season.

"We have found a true home here at The Chapel. This is a place where we can come together as Jews, as one community, and feel comfortable, welcomed, and safe," said Susan Hirschbiel, president of Congregation Ocean Reef. "The outreach from our Chapel partners has been absolutely fantastic in this very painful and difficult time. So many have expressed to me how comforting it is to have this home to come back to at Ocean Reef."

At 6 p.m. Thursday, November 9, the 85th anniversary of Kristallnacht, "a night of broken glass," Chaplain Bob Henley, along with visiting Rabbi Anne Feibelman, will hold a joint event to honor, pray for the state of Israel and all the innocent victims of the brutality of Hamas. The date is symbolic because it references the shards of glass that fell from the windows of Jewish homes, businesses, and synagogues when the Nazis invaded Germany and Austria in orchestrated attacks on November 9th and 10th, 1938.

Continuing in its message of unity, the Protestant and Jewish congregations will also co-host speaker Joshua Greene, who has written extensively about the Holocaust, at 5 p.m. **January 21, 2024.**

Last season, the multi-purpose center hosted 600 events and services with more than 20,000 people walking through its doors. Speaking engagements, music soirees, grief counseling, along with religious services, Bible studies, weddings and vow renewals took place.

The Chapel is also always open to all Ocean Reef Associates at no cost. In fact, when scheduling permits, employees can host their weddings in the main sanctuary without charge, said Chapel Director Jessica Poitevin.

So far more for the upcoming season, 429 congregational and 150 non congregational services and events are planned. Rosary prayer groups, men's Bible studies, potluck gatherings, Christmas and Hanukkah services, kids ministry, weekly meetings of Chapel Women Connect (an interdenominational group), a fashion show, and Forget Me Nots Alzheimer support group are just some of what's on the Chapel calendar.

Debuting next month in the serene Memorial Gardens in the back of The Chapel is the addition of a new water feature and reflection pool. This will serve as a place where people can come to think about their life's blessings, hopes, past mistakes, lost family members and friends, and pray peacefully under the warm and welcoming skies of ORC.

Also donning the east and south sides of the gardens are seven and 10-foot-high granite remembrance walls, with attached plaques in varying sizes, honoring Ocean Reef Members who have passed. These structures are honorariums, not columbariums. No niches with ashes are permitted. The only living person's name permitted on a plaque is adjacent to a deceased Member's name, awaiting an end-of-life date inscription.

Schiavone purchased a plaque to honor her late husband, Ron. The two honeymooned in Ocean Reef in 1982 and soon after became Equity Members. He died in 2011. Active in multiple Chapel committees, she plans to spend a lot of time in the Chapel's gardens.

"Ocean Reef was our place together," she said. "Because of the importance of God in our lives and our trust in his plan, it felt like honoring Ron at The Chapel was the right thing to do. His friends can go there. I can go there. With the world being so topsy-turvy, it's a place I can go as often as I want. He's honored right here in this special place."



Card Sound Road Toll Rate Adjustment

On October 1, 2023, Card Sound Road implemented new toll rates based on the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index. These adjustments aim to support road maintenance and future bridge repairs. Here's a breakdown of the new rates for SunPass and Toll-By-Plate users:

Sunpass Rates:

- Two-axle vehicles (cars, pickups, motorcycles): \$2.00
- Three-axle vehicles: \$3.84
- Each additional axle: \$1.28

Toll-By-Plate Rates:

- Two-axle vehicles (cars, pickups, motorcycles): \$3.00
- Three-axle vehicles: \$5.76
- Each additional axle: \$1.92

Please note that the toll collection is entirely electronic, accepting payments through Toll-By-Plate, SunPass, E-Pass, or EZ-Pass. Cash payments will not be accepted. The generated toll revenue will be allocated towards maintaining the road and addressing the repair and replacement needs of the five bridges along Card Sound Road. For two-axle vehicle owners



with a SunPass account in good standing, two discount programs are available:

Monthly Discount Program:

- No sign-up required.
- Enjoy a 40% rebate on your SunPass account after any calendar month with 28 or more one-way trips through the toll.

Annual Pass:

- Designed for frequent users. Unlimited trips through the toll.
- Available for \$500 annually from January 1 through December 31, 2024.

Annual pass purchase will be possible in December 2023 and January 2024, with more program details to follow.


practice I thoroughly enjoyed. This experience has allowed me to provide a more holistic and effective approach to patient







BRIDGE TIP OF THE WEEK

Invisible Cue-Bids



by Gregg Van Dyke, Director of Card & Games

In a Nutshell

In the late 1970s a concept known as "unusual over unusual" was developed (not sure by whom) to cope with an opponent's unusual 2 NT overcall. While reasonable, its specific application to one type of two-suited overcall was shortsighted. Therefore, I generalized it for all twosuited overcalls and added some additional agreements. Basically, the cheapest bid in an enemy shown suit is

a raise of opener's suit (see details for more).

The name also had to be changed (e.g., "unusual over unusual" sounds stupid if the enemy bid is Michaels) so invisible cue-bids were born. (This was introduced in 1981 in "Modern Bridge Conventions," a book I co-authored with Bill Root.) Alas, the name didn't catch

Details

After a Michaels cue-bid. unusual 2 NT, Roman jump overcall, or any other bid that shows a two-suited hand, the following structure called "invisible cue-bids" applies:

- West 1x
- North Bid*
- East ?
- South
- *2-suited hand

Call

Double New suit Single raise 2 NT 3 NT jump

3 NT nonjump Jump shift Jump raise

Cheapest cue* Higher cue*

Any jump cue*

Meaning

10+; creates forcing auction 6-9; 6+ (good 5) cards; NF

6-9; NF

9-11; natural with fit; I 12-14; natural with fit; NF

9-14; natural with fit; NF weak weak

10+; raise of suit opened 10+ HCP; 5+ 4th suit; F

13+; splinter raise; GF

*A bid is a cue-bid only if the suit was specifically shown. The "higher cue" is available only when two specific suits were shown.

Subsequent bidding:

1. After the "higher cue," if opener rebids in notrump or his original suit, this confirms a minimum and is nonforcing. A "raise" of responder's indicated suit is forcing below game.

2. After doubling, if

responder next bids a new suit or a suit implied by the enemy, it is natural and forcing below game.

3. If responder passes over the two-suited overcall and later bids a suit implied by the enemy, it is natural and nonforcing.


