GOLF ATTIRE:

MEN: Appropriate attire for men is shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks or golf shorts. Golf shorts may not be more than 4 inches above the knee. Tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cut-offs, sweat pants, denim blue jeans, bathing suits and/or tennis shorts or other athletic shorts are not permitted. Men's shirts must be tucked-in. Brim of headwear is forward.

WOMEN: Dresses, skirts, slacks, golf shorts and blouses are considered appropriate attire. Halter tops, fishnet tops, bathing suits, sweat pants, denim blue jeans, tennis dresses, athletic shorts and cut-offs are not permitted. Golf shoes with soft spikes are proper footwear. Sandals and flip-flops are not proper attire.

CLUB ATTIRE:

RACQUET SPORTS:
